

Baernack is to Get His Freedom

Solicitors Say Order of Minister of Justice to That Effect is Expected

By an order of the Minister of Justice, Rudolf Baernack, who was arrested as a spy at the Island filtration plant in December, is to be released from the detention camp at Stanley Barracks, according to the man's solicitors. It has been found, it is said, that Baernack is an Austrian by birth, but that he is a naturalized citizen of over four years' standing. He married a Canadian woman, and his family lives at Burke's Falls. The man is a bricklayer by trade, and he had come to Toronto to seek work, it is declared.
