

WAR PRISONERS SKIP

Two Men Interned in Kingston
Allowed Out on Bail and are Be-
lieved to Have Landed in N. Y.

Kingston, Feb. 18.—Two prisoners of war were given their liberty from Fort Henry a few days ago, on bail being furnished by a local merchant.

It was the understanding that the men should report regularly to the military authorities, but for two days now, they have not put in an appearance, and it is stated, that they skipped to New York, and the local merchant will be asked to put up the bail money.

There will likely be a strict rule now that no more prisoners of war be allowed out on such conditions.
