The old fort at Prescott, after receiving but scant attention for over half a century, has, once more come into being as a detention place for Germans, Austrians and Turks. Even its name, that of Fort Welfington, is once more known. Seventy-five

is once more known. Seventy-nve prisoners are now quartered there and accommodation is being made for 400. It will act as an overflow from Fort Henry of Kingston.
