

# DON'T LIKE PROTEST

## Labor Unionists Disapprove of Expense of Another Municipal Election—Meeting To-night.

From what can be learned in local labor circles it is fully expected that at the semi-monthly meeting of the Allied Trades and Labor Council tonight some very strong protests will be made as to the recent election protest proceedings. A leading official told The Journal recently that the labor men on the whole felt that the burden of taxation was quite heavy enough and that the expense of another election will increase it.

As an investigation has been made into statements, made by a Montreal waiter at the last meeting, who alleged that Germans and Austrians were employed in local hotels, to the exclusion of Canadians and English-speaking persons, the officers who were delegated to make the inquiries will in all probability make their report.

The question of aliens being brought into Canada just now to work may also be brought up and discussed.
