Interned Germans and Austrians Are in Ten Camps.

Ottawa, Feb. 24.—A return tabled in the Commons to-day by the Minister of Justice shows that since the outbreak of the war 2,177 Germans and Austrians have been taken into custody in Canada as prisoners of war. The detention camps are at Halifax, Quebec, Kingston, Petawawa, Spirit Lake, Kapeeskasing, Brandon, Lethbridge, Vernon and Nanaimo.
