

Broke Alien Labor Law

Toronto, March 1.—Prosecuted by Inspector Reynolds, of the Immigration Department, for a breach of the act, R. G. Long and B. S. Sutherland, of R. G. Long and Company, were today fined \$50 and costs for bringing three alien glove-cutters into Canada. The men were turned back at Sarnia, but were later supplied with \$50 each, taken to Detroit and managed to pass the immigration officials. A letter from one of the men, found on another man who was detained at the border, gave a clue which resulted in the prosecution.
