

# GERMAN RESERVISTS WILL BE INTERNED; TRIED TO ESCAPE

## Believed They Were Contem- plating Flight Into U.S. Territory

SASKATOON, Sask., March 3.—Henry Kloth and Gustaf Kloth, German reservists, until a few days ago proprietors of the Alexandra Hotel at Warman, are now lodged in the cells at the city police station awaiting transportation to Brandon where they will be interned with the other alien prisoners of war.

The men were brought down from Warman yesterday by Sergeant Pelcher of the R.N.W.M.P. detachment at Rosthern. It was feared that they were contemplating flight to St. Paul, where it is believed they were in communication with the German consul. They were put under surveillance at the commencement of the war and have been reporting each two days to a justice of the peace.

A few days ago the men applied for leave to go to Manitoba, stating that they intended to rent a farm there. This started renewed investigations. Just what was discovered is not known but the authorities deemed it expedient to place the men under arrest and in all probability they will be detained at Brandon until the end of the war.
