

FOUR AUSTRIANS EFFECT ESCAPE FROM DETENTION

Loosened Board From Floor of Winter Fair Building at Brandon

BRANDON, Man., March 12.—Four Austrian prisoners of war here made a daring get away last night and only one of their number had been recaptured this morning. The men, whose names are not disclosed by the military authorities, managed to secrete a table knife, and after many hours of patient work succeeded in loosening a board in the floor of the old winter fair building. It was through this that the quartette made their escape, their get away eventually being covered to a considerable extent by their fellow prisoners. Large parties of pickets are out today searching for the fugitives, whose apprehension is hourly expected.
