

# GERMANS RESIDING IN VANCOUVER ARE PUT UNDER ARREST

VANCOUVER, April 29.—Four prominent Germans of Vancouver, Paul Koop, a capitalist; Baron von Luttwitz, a relative and intimate friend of the kaiser; Dr. Otto Grunert and Frederick Stitzel, were arrested to-day because the police believe that on Sunday night the quartette, with a number of compatriots, engaged in a celebration of the German advance against Canadian troops at Ypres. It happened that the first and a very heavy casualty list of Vancouver men killed and wounded reached Vancouver Sunday night and it was an unlucky time for the Germans to select to celebrate anything. The Germans concerned declare they were merely having a house warming, the party having been arranged several days previously. It is probable the four will be sent to a detention camp for alien enemies at Nanaimo.
