

TWO GERMANS WOUNDED.

Interned Men at Fort Henry Attacked
Guards and Were Resisted With
Bayonets.

Kingston, Ont., April 27.—Two interned Germans were wounded last night at Fort Henry, when they and some of their fellow prisoners made an attack on two guards, who were serving them with supper. The guards drew their bayonets and a lively fight followed, in which one German was wounded near the heart and is in a dangerous condition, while the other was stabbed in the wrist. The two injured Germans had been kept in confinement on account of misbehaviour.
