

## **NO NATURALIZATION PAPERS**

**Will Be Required To Be Carried By  
American Tourists.**

American Consul F. S. S. Johnson has been advised that German-American tourists coming to Canada this summer will not be required to show their naturalization papers. It was at first announced that Canadian immigration officers would be instructed to demand the passports of German subjects of the United States, but now the Canadian Government announces that this course will not be followed out. It is the Government's intention to make tourists as welcome as possible.
