

Alien Prisoners Are In Custody At Halifax

Ottawa, May 7.—German officers and men to the number of 350, recently brought from Jamaica to Amherst, and now interned at Halifax, were taken off German warships and merchant vessels, including the Kaiser Wilhelm der Grasse.

Officers of the Dominion Police have apprehended four Austrians who were on parole at Montreal, and tried to escape to the United States, by way of Prescott.

A party of one hundred Austrians have just been sent to the Kapuskasing Camp from Port Arthur and Port William, while another hundred are going this week from Montreal to the Spirit Lake Internment Camp ground.
