

May Intern Foreigners In Britain

London, May 12.—So serious has the "alien enemy" problem become that a special cabinet meeting was called to-day to discuss it. There is a growing feeling that all persons of German, Turkish or Austrian birth, whether naturalized or not, should be interned until the end of the war.

It is believed that the cabinet will authorize such action as an internal peace measure, owing to the growing anti-German riots throughout the country.
