GERMAN PUBLICATIONS Greater Vigilance To Be Exercises Against Their Entry. Ottawa, May 21.—Notice have been sent out by the customs department to the effect that greater

vigilance must be exercised against the entry into Canada of German publications. Information has been received that enemy publications are coming into the Dominion by mail and express, in spite of the fact this is prohibited under the provisions of the proclamations relating

to trading with the enemy.

Among such publications a book entitled "Fur Vaterland Und Ehre," or "For Fatherland and Honor," is reported as having a large sale in this country through a St. Louis

publishing house.
