

REINFORCEMENTS FOR FRONT GO SATURDAY

Farewells Must All be Said Friday Evening as Departure is Timed for 3.40 Saturday Morning — Lieutenant Gracen Commands the Party—Virден Detachment on Same Train

An early morning departure will be made by Lieut. Gracen and the fifty-two men of the 45th Battalion, who will go as reinforcements to the front. They will take the 3:40 train on the C. P. R. Saturday morning, two cars being attached for their accommodation. On the same train will be the Virден detachment. The remainder of the 45th now at Brandon will leave

Saturday morning at 8:30. About 150 men will be kept here to guard the prisoners of war, and the remainder, about 350, soon depart for Sewell.

Arrangements for the taking over of the interned aliens by some troops other than the 45th are still under way. Like the C.M.R.'s, the 45th expect a short stay at Sewell and are hopeful of crossing the Atlantic at a very early date.
