If any, alien enemies, Germans or Austrians, have any arms in their possession, they will show considerable discretion by handing the same promptly over to the police, or they are likely to meet the same fate as befell Alex Kowbiasink at the hands of Magistrate Primrose this morning. The police had complaints made to them that the accused had certain arms in his possession, and upon Detectives Effenberger and Shaw making a search of the prisoner's shack, after some time they found a shot gun hidden, the barrel being in one place and the stock in another.
