

STELTON DISCUSSES MEANS TO PROVIDE FOR ALIEN FAMILIES

While the Bread Winners are
Interned by the the
Military Authorities

A matter discussed at last night's Steelton council meeting was that of providing for the families of aliens who are interned by the military authorities and are sent up north to clear the land. There are at the present time in the town a number of families in such a position, the town having to provide for them. In regard to this the council decided to notify the Minister of Lands, Forests and Mines and see if something can be done by the Government to provide for these helpless families.

A letter was received from London Ont. asking the council to send a petition to the Government to amend the Colonization Act. This means that the Government should help the foreigners of the agricultural class to get a start with their farms by giving them a grant of money and providing them with seed the first year, for which they were to pay when their farms were being worked to advantage. Councillor Caesar thought that the Government should provide for the Canadians first and limit the immigration. "There are lots of Canadians looking for just such a chance," said Mr. Caesar.
