

## PRO-GERMAN WHO CIRCULATED LITERATURE IN QUEBEC ARRESTED AT TORONTO

Toronto, June 5.— The World says Martin Sichel, of Montreal, was arrested last night at the Union station by detective Maurer, charged with having pro-German literature in his possession. He is supposed to have been instrumental in circulating much literature in Quebec Province. When he was arrested he had copies of the Fatherland upholding the torpedoing of the Lusitania and attacking the manufacture of shells by the United States for Great Britain.
