

Fernie Strikers Back at Work

*So Are the Aliens Who Have
Not Been Locked Up;
Conference On*

Fernie, June 10.—The strike of the miners who refused to work with Germans and Austrians, has been temporarily declared off, while a deputation will approach the authorities with a view to a permanent settlement of the difficulties. In the meantime all nationalities have resumed their respective occupations, the present internment regulations being strictly enforced; 125 aliens are now in custody here; three hundred more expected to arrive to-day.
