

ALIENS MAY BE HOUSED IN TENTS NEAR ASYLUM

Col. Clark Has Prepared Plans and Estimates of Cost for Authorities—Told The Sun Friday Nothing in Rumored Change of Housing Quarters

The transferring of the interned aliens to a camp east of the asylum is being considered by the military authorities at Ottawa. This information was obtained from Col. Clark this morning. The Colonel was asked some days ago to prepare plans of a camp and estimates as to the cost of

fencing, sleeping quarters, cook houses, etc., and has sent these estimates and plans to Ottawa. He expects a reply in a few days. On Friday evening Colonel Clark told the Sun there was not foundation for the rumor that the aliens would be housed in tents near the Asylum.
