

Aliens at Fernie Told to Report

Failure to Visit Provincial Police Chief Would Mean Internment

Fernie, B.C., June 15.—Following complications arising here last week when a brief cessation of work at the mines occurred, owing to the employment of Austrians and Germans, and when the Provincial military authorities enforced the internment of all unnaturalized alien enemies, to-day, immediately following the arrival of Colonel McPherson, despatched from Ottawa by Major-General Otter, notices were posted through the town ordering all Austrians and Germans, whether naturalized or not, to report to the chief of the Provincial police.

The penalty for failure to report would be immediate internment. Over three hundred have already been interned here in accordance with the first order.
