

## Alien Enemy Fined

Constantine Botha, who was recently found not guilty by Mr. Justice Hyndman of having explosives in his possession, as an alien enemy, prejudicial to the public peace, owing to the fact that it had not been proved that it was prejudicial to the public peace, again appeared in the dock.

At the time he was committed for trial by Magistrate Primrose there were other charges laid against him and which were not proceeded with. However, this morning he was charged with being an alien enemy in possession of firearms and was defended by A. E. E. H. Jackson. He was found guilty and sentenced to pay a fine of \$300 or in default to go to jail for three months, to date from the time of the prisoner's arrest.
