Four Others Wounded In Outbreak at Internment Camp. AMHERST, N.S., June 25 .- During an outbreak early yesterday at the allen enemy internment camp near Amherst, one of the prisoners. Fritz Chause, a German, was shot dead, and four others, also said to be Germans, were seriously wounded. A rumor was abroad during the day that the shooting occurred while a squad of German prisoners attempted to escape. Few details are obtainable.
