

# Interned German Shot Dead at Amherst N.S.

FOUR OTHERS SERIOUSLY WOUNDED—ATTACKED GUARDS WHILE  
BEING GIVEN EXERCISES.

Amherst, N. S., June 25.—A disturbance occurred at the internment camp here in which one German prisoner is reported to have been shot dead and four others seriously wounded. Few details are available, but it is reported that while the prisoners were being taken out for exercise one of them named Fritz Clause assaulted a guard, knocking him insensible. The camp police were called in and before the riot was quelled Clause was shot dead and the others wounded.
