

# *End Pension to German Professor*

## *And Accept Resignation of Another—Board of Govern- ors Acts*

The incident of the German professors at Varsity was closed at the last meeting of the Board of Governors, when the pension of \$800 of Prof. August Kirschman was cut

off and the resignation of Prof. P. W. Mueller was accepted.

—Prof. Kirschman, who was head of the Philosophy Department, returned to Germany on sick leave about five years ago. Since then he received \$1,500, and later \$800 a year. When the Board of Governors found that he was in Germany, not in Switzerland, as they had thought, his pension was definitely cut off.

Prof. Mueller had obtained a substitute, and is teaching at McMaster University. His resignation is accepted as from the end of the school year, July 1.
