OVER 5,000 ALIENS IN CANADIAN CAMPS

The Germans at Fort Henry Have Athletic Club and an Orchestra.

Kingston, July 8.—Baron Polanz is the moving spirit among the Germans interned at Fort Henry. He has arranged athletic work so that they might not become weary of their confinement.

There is also a singing society of forty voices and an orchestra of fifteen pieces. A garden has been made in the centre of the court, and some fine flowers and vegetables are grown. In the fort at the present time there are 245 Germans, 1,000 Austrians and one Turk. In the various camps all over Canada there are 1,000 Germans, 4,000 Austrians and 130 Turks.
