## STRIKE AT STEEL MILLS AT THE SOO

British and Russian Laborers Quit Work—Wages Reduced

Sault Ste. Marie. July 19.—
Three hundred British and Russian laborers in the steel mills at the Canadian Soo are on strike.
The laborers had been threatening to strike because they were working with German and Austrian laborers, but the crisis was precipitated when the company

announced a ten per cent, decrease in wages. The strikers are holding meetings and further complications are threatened. The steel mills had received a commission from the government to produce bullet metal in unlimited quantities until further notice.
