

CHARGED WITH RUNNING ALIENS ACROSS BORDER

Montreal Cab Driver Said to
Have Carried on Lucra-
tive Business.

MONTREAL, July 26.—A Montreal cab driver, Albert Harden, appeared in the police court this morning on a serious charge. Information was laid by Major Tate, provost marshal of this district, and Harden is charged with "inciting and assisting subjects of foreign states at war with His Majesty to leave Canada without the consent of the Crown."

It is stated that Harden has been soliciting and carrying Austrians and Germans across the border to the United States. He charged a stated fee and the men were taken in an automobile along unfrequented roads at night and across the border via the eastern townships. Harden was remanded until Wednesday.
