

CONDITION OF ALIENS PLEASES GENERAL OTTER

**Visits Interned Aliens at Winter
Fair Arena and Inspects Quar-
ters and Men**

SOUNDS FIRE ALARM

**To See that Men Understand Pre-
cautions for Their Safety in
a Fire**

To inspect the aliens interned in the city, Major-General Sir William Otter, K.C.B., C.V.O., arrived in the city last night. The 900 prisoners were formed up in lines as for medical parade, while the General inspected them. To see that proper precautions were being taken to prevent fire he had the fire alarm sounded and the guard called out to extinguish the imaginary blaze. He also examined the quarters of the aliens and looked over the books showing their records.

General Otter expressed himself as being well pleased with conditions in the interment camp. This afternoon he leaves to inspect the camp at Lethbridge.
