## A Serious Charge Employee of G.T.R. Are Said to be Smuggling Foreigners Out of Canada Sarnia, Aug. 12—That employee of the Grand Trunk Railway in Toronto are receiving money from foreigners

for taking them to points outside of Canada is stated when three foreigners were deported from Port Huron, where they were shipped from Toronto in an empty freight car.
