

TOOK ALIENS TO BORDER

Windsor, Ont., Aug. 19.—William Lonnee, alias "Shump" Lonnee, son of a former Windsor alderman, admitted he had broken the immigration law by smuggling undesirables from Canada into the United States, that he induced Austrians to cross the river with him for hire and then had "tipped" the provincial police to the game, and that even after betraying the Austrians accepted \$12 from them; when he appeared before Judge J. O. Dromgole in Sandwich on a charge of smuggling alien enemies from the country.

Following this admission, Judge Dromgole denounced the prisoner and condemned the practice as a disgrace. He promised little consideration for those convicted of smuggling aliens across the river.

"A business has been made of smuggling, and dishonestly at that," he said.
