Von Bessler New Governor of Captured Poland

Amsterdam, Aug. 28 .- Word was received here to-day from Berlin that General von Bessler. conqueror of Antwerp and Novo Georgievsk, has been appointed Governor-General of the entire occupied Russian territory. This announcement, which is credited to The Posen Tageblatt, says that the civil administration of Russian Poland, heretofore at Kalicz, has been removed to Warsaw.

There were thousands of English friends at the station to wish them Godspeed. Since the declaration of war with Turkey practically every Italian reservist in Canada has been called to the colors.
