

MORTENSEN GIVEN SIX MONTHS BY THE FEDERAL COURT

Sentenced for Bringing Aus-
trians Into the United
States

DEPORTED WHEN JAIL
SENTENCE COMPLETED

And Will Likely be Tried by
Canadian Authorities
for Treason

Neils Mortensen was sentenced to six months in prison, according to Inspector Ross, of the local immigration office, who has returned from being a witness in the case at this term of the United States Federal court in Marquette. Mortensen is the farmer near Point Aux Pins who confessed to smuggling thirteen Austrians into this country from Canada. After his jail sentence is up Mortensen will be deported, when his troubles will really begin, as he will probably be arraigned for treason by the Canadian authorities.
