

Would Ban All Germans.

Chevalier J. Enoch Thompson, Spanish Consul, has started a movement in Toronto to have no truck or trade with the Germans, not only for the duration of the war, but forever. The following document is now being circulated and signed:

"The undersigned British subjects are in favor of organizing a league, the members of which are to pledge themselves neither to buy from, sell to, nor trade with Germans, nor to use German goods, nor employ any Germans. This league to be continued after the war."

Mr. Thompson suggests the following as tenets of the league:

"Never to have any intercourse with a German, either social or commercial.

"Never to buy from or sell to a German."

"Never permit a German article in his house.

"Never to deal with a merchant who keeps a single article of German manufacture in his store.

"Never to travel in Germany nor permit any of his family to visit there.

"Permit no Germans to enter Canada, except on higher terms than Chinese—a head tax of \$1,000."
