

ASSERTS DISTRICT WILL GET GRANT

Prospects for a Dominion government land grant to the Greater Winnipeg Water District railroad as a colonization road and also of financial assistance from the government to help in establishing the proposed colonization scheme of placing unemployed on forty-acre farms, are exceedingly bright, according to an announcement made by Mayor Waugh today. When the mayor was in the east, a few days ago he took up the matter with Hon. J. C. Doherty, minister of justice, who was very favorably impressed with the scheme. His worship will take Hon. Robert Rogers, minister of public works, over the district on Nov. 10, and expects a final decision from the government shortly after the inspection trip is made.

The proposal to utilize the labor of interned aliens to clear the farms was also favorably considered by Mr. Doherty, and the mayor thinks that permission to do this will be secured.
