

A worthy and esteemed resident of Petawawa, Mr Herman Priebe, died on Friday morning last after a somewhat lengthy illness, though he had been confined to bed for only about two weeks. Mr Priebe had suffered for quite a long time from asthma, and finally inflammation of the lungs developed, and he was not able to withstand the combined attack. The late Mr Priebe was a native of Germany and was sixty-three years of age. He came to Canada with his parents when only eight years old. They settled on a farm in Alice, but moved later to Petawawa, and there, on the same farm, now owned by his son, Mr John Priebe, he remained until his death. He is survived by his widow, one son (John), and three daughters. The daughters are Mrs Albert Sack, Mrs John Milkie and Mrs George Sunnenburg, all of Petawawa. The funeral took place on Sunday afternoon to the Evangelical Lutheran church and cemetery at Petawawa, Rev. Mr Meyer, of Pembroke, officiating. There was a large attendance of friends and neighbors.
