by some of his friends across the border, and as a result an application has been made at Ottawa for the recease of the prisoner. Ripton was taken in charge while the Barriefield camp was on. He enlisted with one of the overseas battalions, and it is alleged that he attempted to tap the wires at the camp to secure in-

formation.

Ripton, so it is understood, came from Quebec, but when he enlisted for overseas service he claimed that he was a Canadian. His case is now

being considered.
