

GERMANS TO RULE WORLD, HE SAYS

Remark at Breakfast Table Brings Fred Saffley to Court On Sedition Charge

"You will see the day when the Germans rule the whole world. The British can steal from the poor Turks and Austrians, but they cannot put one over the Germans."

For this remark made Nov. 11, while at breakfast in a boarding house, Fred Laffley has been held at Fort Osborne barracks. On Tuesday afternoon he will come up before Magistrate A. L. Bonnycastle on a charge of sedition. He is now on bail, but has spent two weeks in the guard room.

Magistrate A. L. Bonnycastle told him Friday that he should be careful of his utterance at this time when the world is in a tumult over the war and then remanded the case until Tuesday with John Allen, deputy attorney general, as prosecutor.
