Sarnia Austrian Tried to Aid War Prisoners

Sarnia, Ont., December 6.—Convicted of attempting to assist prisoners of war to escape from Canada, Nick Pochoreskczzk, a local Austrian, was today sentenced by Police Magistrate Gorman to one year in prison, and on the expiration of his term he will be interned until the end of the war. It was found that the prisoner had written letters to fellow-countrymen being held in a detention camp near Brandon, Man., giving them advice as to how to escape, and offering his assistance in that regard.
