CHARGES OF HIGH TREASON.

D. Nelman Accused of Helping **Enemy** **Allies** to Leave Canada.

(Canadian Press Despatch.)

Winnipeg, Dec. 24.—David Nelman was this morning charged by the Intelligence Department of the military before Magistrate Bonnycastle in the Police Court with three charges of high treason. It is alleged Nelman helped two Austrians and one German

to leave Canada and enter the United States, they intending to return to their own country and fight against the Entente allies. Nelman was remanded for a week.
