1). Neiman Accused of Helping Enemy

- Aliens to Leave Canada, (Canadian Press Despatch.)

Winnipeg, Dec. 24.—David Neiman

was this morning charged by the Intelligence Department of the military before Magistrate Bonnycastle in the Polico Court with three charges of high treason. It is alleged Neiman helped two Austrians and one German to leave Canada and enter the United States, they intending to return to their own country and fight against the Entento allies. Neiman was rcmanded for a week.
