

'SVOBODA' INCURS GOVERNMENT'S IRE

Ruthenian Newspaper Refused Use of Canadian Mails Un- der Heavy Penalties

OTTAWA, Jan. 21—By order-in-council, the Ukranian (Ruthenian) daily newspaper, "Svoboda," published in New Jersey, has been refused the privileges of Canadian mails as from Jan. 17. In future any person found with the "Svoboda" in his possession, selling or endeavoring to smuggle same through the mails, will be liable to severe penalty. "Svoboda," which has a large circulation among Ruthenians in Western Canada, has been carrying on an insidious, though none the less dangerous, campaign in support of the Teutonic cause, the government believes.
