

WANTED PRISONER FREED FROM FORT.

Young Man From Trenton Was Taken in Charge and Put in Police Celis.

Sympathy for an Austrian friend led to serious trouble for a young man hailing from Trenton. On Thursday night the Chief of Police at Trenton in company with another constable, brought an Austrian down to Kingston to be interned at Fort Henry.

It is stated that the young man followed the officers and their man to Fort Henry and was bold enough to ask that the Austrian be given his liberty, but of course there was nothing doing. Canada's war effort must not be tampered with, and as a result of his actions, the young man was taken in charge and brought to the police station, where he is now being held.

On Friday afternoon the young man was released and sent back to Trenton. Constable James Hateson escorted him into the train.
