

SOLDIERS ATTACKED PRO-GERMAN PASTOR.

Police Court Case at Berlin, Ont.—Two Soldiers Plead- ed Guilty.

Berlin, Ont., March 6.—Two soldiers, who assumed full responsibility for the attack made upon Rev. K. C. Tappert, alleged pro-German by a squad of fifty soldiers on Saturday night, were to-day found guilty of aggravated assault by Police Magistrate J. J. Weir, and were remanded until Wednesday for sentence. They are Sergeant-Major Granville Blood and Private Samuel Schaefer. Both men were allowed out on bond.
