

KOHLER STREET NOT NAMED AFTER GERMAN

Rev. Father Richard Says Thoroughfare Bears Name of Former Soo Alsatian Priest

Referring to a letter that appeared in the Star on Monday suggesting that the name of Kohler street be changed because of its German sound, Rev. Father Richard, the popular Roman Catholic Missionary, has called our attention to the fact that this street was named after Rev. Father Kohler, an Alsatian priest, who left his native Alsace for Canada many years before the Franco-Prussian war of 1870, when Alsace was still a French province. Father Kohler, who worked for several years in this section, was drowned in Lake Huron about 35 years ago.
