

# NO MENTION OF NIAGARA CAMP

## In Official Memorandum of Militia Department Brought Before House

Ottawa, April 6.—The official memorandum of the Militia Department laid on the table of the House yesterday, shows that it has not yet been decided where to concentrate in training camps the troops now quartered in the London and Toronto districts.

It is understood that Petewawa is to be the training camp for Ontario and that the alien enemies interned at Petewawa will be removed to some other point.

The memorandum shows that there will be a detachment at London or some other point in the London military district, but indicates that the location of the main body of the troops has not yet been decided upon.

No mention is made in the memorandum of the Niagara Camp, and there is a possibility that it may not be used and the Toronto regiments will be all sent to Petewawa. However, apparently this is not yet settled.

The troops in the Kingston district will be all sent to Petewawa less a detachment at Barriefield.

In Quebec the troops will be all concentrated at Valcartier, while the Maritime Province troops will be sent to Valcartier, less a detachment at Camp Aldershot in Nova Scotia.

The Manitoba and Saskatchewan troops will be sent to Camp Hughes, near Brandon.

The Alberta troops will be at Sarcee Reserve at Calgary, while the British Columbia troops will be trained at Vernon, less a detachment on the Island of Vancouver.
