

~~INTERNED~~ GERMANS ESCAPE.

Dug Tunnel With Kitchen Utensils From Lethbridge Camp.

Lethbridge, Alta., May 1.—Six German prisoners have made a sensational escape from the detention camp here, tunneling a passage four and a half feet underground and 110 feet long, leading from the bunk house under the compound fence to the centre of the city nurseries adjoining the camp. No trace of their whereabouts has yet been received. The prisoners used implements stolen from the kitchen in the work of tunneling, used a mine fan made by one of them for supplying them with air while tunneling, and made candles out of grease and tallow. Each man who escaped carried a knapsack with provisions saved from the daily meals or stolen from the kitchen.
