

ASK INTERNMENT CAMPS TO SUPPLY LABOR SHORTAGE

The Steady Enlistment About Kingston Taking Up All Available Help

KINGSTON, Ont., May 19.—The Kingston board of public works is applying to General Otter, in charge of the internment camps of Canada, to permit the use of Germans imprisoned in Fort Henry on the city roads and excavations. It is impossible to get laborers here owing to the steady enlistment. Many of the Germans are eager to be allowed to work.
