

Plans Complete For Camp Hughes Road

Arrangements are now virtually completed to start work on the Brandon-Camp Hughes road which is to be constructed by alien enemies interned at Brandon camp. Alex McGillivray, provincial highways commissioner, announced Tuesday that all
