

AMERICAN CONSUL INSPECTS THE FORT.

Found Everything in Splendid Shape—Prisoners Satisfied With Treatment.

The U. S. Consul, Felix S. S. Johnson, inspected Fort Henry on Wednesday, and found everything to be in splendid shape. A number of complaints were investigated, but were found to be groundless.

The Consul states that of the 400 prisoners, two-thirds are satisfied, and commend Major Campbell for his considerate treatment of them.

A number of improvements are being made to the Fort. Cement floors are laid in the corridors, and new flooring in the rooms, and the drainages is being improved. Progress is being made with the new roof.
